

HOW TO DOWNLOAD AUTODESK INVENTOR

We use Autodesk Inventor to CAD on the Hunter Robotics Team. This sheet contains instructions for people with access to WINDOWS about how to download it for free.

Install Autodesk Inventor **2020** at this link, free for students:

Make an account: You will be asked to enter your name, your email and create a password.

Verify your account after receiving the verification to your email. Then, enter your school (Hunter College High School), your Area of Study, and your enrollment information at Hunter.

Once you have made an account, you can install the software (the installation process can be lengthy depending on your computer, plan for that!) After your installation is done, you are **all ready** to CAD whatever you want!

* While the team uses Autodesk Inventor, Autodesk Fusion 360 is also a useful tool if you want to use CAD for your own purposes. You can download it on a Mac or on Windows, and it is becoming increasingly popular in mechanical engineering classes.
